## Children & Youth Partnership for Dare County Training Descriptions

### Administration of Medication in Child Care—Part 2

To be able to participate in this training, Part 1 must be completed on Moodle within the past 3 years. A valid Moodle certificate is required to register! Participants will learn the six rights of medication administration, the steps for receiving, preparing, administering, and documenting medication, the skills needed to safely administer different types of medication to children, and the most common medication errors and rule violations, how to prevent them from happening, and how to document errors if they occur. This training covers oral, topical, inhalation, and instillation medication and the use of epinephrine auto-injectors. It will NOT cover other types of injectable medication, infusion medication or rectal gels. Training will be provided by an RN partner. Any person who will administer medication at a child care program should take this training. Available in-person only through a CCHC. (2.5 credits)

### ITS-SIDS - Infant/Toddler Safe Sleep & SIDS Risk Reduction in Child Care training.

Learn how to provide a safe sleep environment for infants in a childcare setting. Training is required every three years and within two months of hire for staff and volunteers, and family childcare homes providers licensed to care for infants.

## **Playground Safety**

NC Child Care Playground Safety Training aims to provide you with all the necessary knowledge and tools to ensure that your outdoor learning environment will meet North Carolina Division of Child Development and Early Education requirements and provide your children a safe and fun environment. It addresses playground safety hazards, supervision, and general upkeep of the outdoor area. It is required for all licensed child care centers, but has very helpful and important information for family child care home providers as well.

## **Supporting Developmental Monitoring and Screening in Early Care and Education Settings**

We know that monitoring and screening in early childhood early care and education settings is critical to identifying children at risk for developmental delays. What is less known is how programs use developmental monitoring and screening tools and ways caregivers talk with families about their children's growth and development. This training will help participants understand the differences in developmental monitoring and screening and why they are so important to children and families. Participants will learn how they can track and celebrate children's milestones and strategies for collaborating with families on supporting children's healthy growth. You can play an essential role in our state's early intervention efforts!

## **Emergency Preparedness and Response in Child Care Training**

Emergency preparedness and response (EPR) rules went into effect July 1, 2015. The rules and training are designed to assist licensed child care programs to be adequately prepared to respond to the needs of children and others in the event of disasters and emergencies. Participants will learn about the rules and the required emergency preparedness and response plan. **Additional EPR training may be scheduled in Dare County as needed, upon request. ## **Improving Classroom Quality with the ITERS-R**

Would you like to gain a better understanding of the Infant Toddler Environment Rating Scale? This training will be a discussion to define what quality care looks like in an infant/toddler classroom. Participants will learn about the indicators of quality in infant and toddler settings, how the scale measures quality, and how to use the scale as a self-assessment tool. It is recommended that participants have a copy of the ITERS R.

## **Introduction to the ECERS-R**

This workshop will review the items and indicators as described in the ECERS Revised Edition, describe furnishings, arrangement of space, and materials recommended for a high quality learning environment, define frequently used terms in the ECERS R, and ultimately reflect on their own classroom and practices in regard to the ECERS R to implement a high quality environment. It is recommended that participants have a copy of the ECERS R.

### **Guiding the Behavior of Young Children**

This workshop is from the Program for Infant and Toddler Care (PITC). We will explore how the developmental characteristics of infants and toddlers influence behaviors we find challenging. We will review useful prevention, guidance, and discipline techniques caregivers can implement to support social emotional skills.

### **Flexible, Fearful, or Feisty: The Different Temperaments of Infants and Toddlers**

This session explores various temperamental styles of infants and toddlers identified in research studies by Stella Chess, M.D., and Alexander Thomas, M.D. Nine identified traits can be grouped into three temperamental styles: flexible, fearful, or feisty. Techniques are described for dealing with children of different temperaments in infant/toddler groups.

### **Providing Responsive Personal Care Routine for Infants and Toddlers in Group Care**

This course will review the ITERS-R's Personal Care Routines and the importance of providing responsive care. Infants and toddlers who receive warm and responsive care are more likely to trust others, to enter school ready and eager to learn, and to get along well with other children. Participants will learn how to adapt to individual and developmental feeding, sleeping and toileting schedules while attending to recommended health and safety practices.
