Children & Youth Partnership for Dare County Training Descriptions

ITS-SIDS - Infant/Toddler Safe Sleep & SIDS Risk Reduction in Child Care training. Learn how to provide a safe sleep environment for infants in a childcare setting. Training is required every three years and within two months of hire for staff and volunteers, and family childcare home providers licensed to care for infants.

Playground Safety

NC Child Care Playground Safety Training aims to provide you with all the necessary knowledge and tools to ensure that your outdoor learning environment will meet the North Carolina Division of Child Development and Early Education requirements and provide your children with a safe and fun environment. It addresses playground safety hazards, supervision, and general upkeep of the outdoor area. It is required for all licensed child care centers but has very helpful and important information for family child care home providers as well.

Supporting Developmental Monitoring and Screening in Early Care and Education Settings

We know that monitoring and screening in early childhood early care and education settings are critical to identifying children at risk for developmental delays. What is less known is how programs use developmental monitoring and screening tools and the ways caregivers talk with families about their children's growth and development. This training will help participants understand the differences in developmental monitoring and screening and why they are so important to children and families. Participants will learn how they can track and celebrate children's milestones and strategies for collaborating with families on supporting children's healthy growth. You can play an essential role in our state's early intervention efforts!

Emergency Preparedness and Response in Child Care Training

Emergency preparedness and response (EPR) rules went into effect July 1, 2015. The rules and training are designed to assist licensed child care programs in being adequately prepared to respond to the needs of children and others in the event of disasters and emergencies. Participants will learn about the rules and the required emergency preparedness and response plan. **Additional EPR training may be scheduled in Dare County as needed, upon request. Introduction to the ECERS-R

This workshop will review the items and indicators as described in the ECERS Revised Edition, describe furnishings, arrangement of space, and materials recommended for a high-quality learning environment, define frequently used terms in the ECERS R, and ultimately reflect on their own classroom and practices regarding the ECERS R to implement a high-quality environment. It is recommended that participants have a copy of the ECERS R.

CSEFEL Module One Infant and Toddler: Social Emotional Development within the Context of Relationships

This workshop is from the Center on the Social Emotional Foundations for Early Learning (CSEFEL). We will define social-emotional development and describe how it unfolds in the context of caregiving relationships. Reflect on how culture (perceptions, beliefs, values) influences caregiving, parenting, and the social-

emotional development of infants and toddlers. Understand and describe that all young children’s behavior is a way of communicating and has meaning. Use a variety of strategies, including self-reflection and observation, to increase their capacity to support the social-emotional development of infants, toddlers, and their families.

CSEFEL Module Two Infant and Toddler: Responsive Routines and Environments, to Support Social-Emotional Development in Infants and Toddlers

This workshop is from the Center on the Social Emotional Foundations for Early Learning (CSEFEL). We will explore strategies that can be used to (1) build positive relationships with infants and toddlers; (2) design environments, schedules, and routines; (3) structure transitions; (4) help children learn rules and routines; (5) plan activities that promote engagement.

Providing Responsive Personal Care Routine for Infants and Toddlers in Group Care

Participants will understand The 10 Keys to Culturally Sensitive Childcare and will learn that each of us has a lens through which we view the world. Participants will learn that identity formation is a critical part of development in the first three years of life and that language and culture are closely tied to a child’s self-esteem, sense of belongingness, and feelings of security. When we create consistency between home culture and program, we establish an ongoing partnership with parents
